PRINTING

The majority of our downloads are formatted to print on 8.5x11” paper unless otherwise noted. You may print at home or a local print shop. We recommend using a recent version of Adobe Acrobat PDF Reader to view and print your files. It is available for free online. If you run into problems with pages being cut off, select “fit to page” in your print dialogue box to make sure it fits on your page correctly.

To print large page sizes (anything larger than 8.5x11”), we recommend going to a local print shop like Kinko’s, Staples, AlphaGraphics, etc. and ask them to print your file as a black and white “engineer print” or “blueprint.” These larger prints are big, fun and fairly inexpensive.

If the staff at your print shop asks you about your rights to reproduce this work, you will find a copyright release below. Or you can tell them you downloaded these files for personal use from comefollowmefhe.com and they can look us up to see if you do have the rights to print the copies.

Hum Your Favorite Hymn

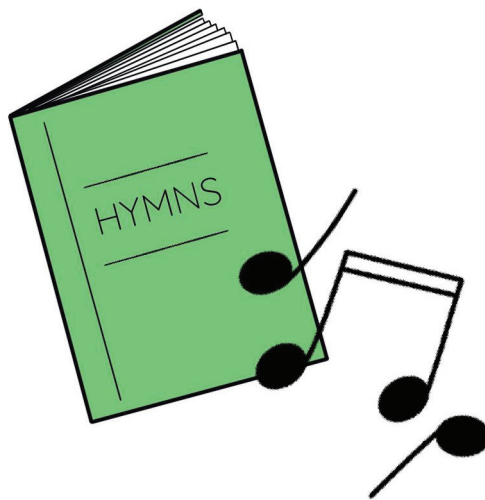
In Doctrine and Covenants 25, we learn that Emma Smith was an “elect lady” who was called by God “to write, to expound scriptures” and to “make a selection of sacred hymns.” (D&C 25:11)

1. Print the hymn cards double-sided with the hymn book image page on the back. Cut out the cards and place them face down in a pile.

2. To play: draw a card (don’t show anyone), hum the tune of the first line of the hymn listed on the card and see if anyone can guess which hymn it is.

3. If no one can guess after the first line is hummed, hum the next line and on until someone can guess the correct hymn.

*If you don’t know the tune, you can pull it up in the Gospel Library app and play it.
